## Leadership Donelson-Hermitage M3 Class Member Requirements

- Attendance at Orientation is mandatory.
  - Attendance at Retreat is mandatory.
  - Attendance required at least 6 of the 7 scheduled Class Program Days.
  - There will be evaluations for the retreat and each of the program days. These are anonymous and will be completed at the end of the day.
  - Class will participate in a mandatory service project to be selected by the group from eligible charitable organizations, in the Donelson-Hermitage service area. Project is a minimum of 4 hours.
  - Everything on this list will be discussed in detail during Orientation and Retreat, however you may contact the Executive Director or M3 Chair Kathy Cochran 615-210-2950 for more information at any time.
  - Many program days will be visits to various sites and will require some walking.
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- LDH Service Area is defined by the following: The Eastern boundary is the Wilson County Line from Percy Priest Lake to the Cumberland River. Follow the river around Old Hickory and Pennington Bend toward downtown Nashville. At Fessler's Lane, cut across to I-24 East to Harding Place and go east to Murfreesboro Road. Turn SE on Murfreesboro Road to Old Murfreesboro Road SE to Smith Springs Road East. Follow Smith Springs Road to Percy Priest Lake. Cross the lake to the starting point of the Wilson County Line.
